All applications received are reviewed independently and subject to criteria review guidelines. Nominations are considered by a review committee consisting of Diabetes Feet Australia Steering Committee members and Australian Diabetes Society representatives. The award winner will be announced and presented with their award at the upcoming DFA 2025 Conference.

Two letters of recommendation must be submitted as part of the nomination process. If self-nominating, the first letter of recommendation can be utilised.
